

## REPORTING NOTICE 01 OF 2022

### CALL FOR SUBMISSION OF THE ANNUAL VERIFIED B-BBEE COMPLIANCE REPORTS IN RELATION TO SECTION 10 (4) OF THE B-BBEE ACT OF 2003 FOR THE MEASUREMENT PERIOD ENDING BETWEEN 1 DECEMBER 2020 AND 30 NOVEMBER 2021.

The FSTC hereby issues a notice for submission of B-BBEE Reports for the 2020/2021 measurement period in accordance with Section 10 (4) of the B-BBEE Act 53 of 2003 and Statement FS 000, Paragraph 8.4 of the Financial Sector Code (FS Code) which requires for each entity conducting business in the South African financial sector to report annually to the Financial Sector Transformation Council (FSTC) on its progress in implementing the provisions of the Financial Sector Code.

In order to comply with the provisions of the Financial Sector Code, the FSTC is requesting for submission of the following documents in line with the requirements of the B-BBEE Act:
